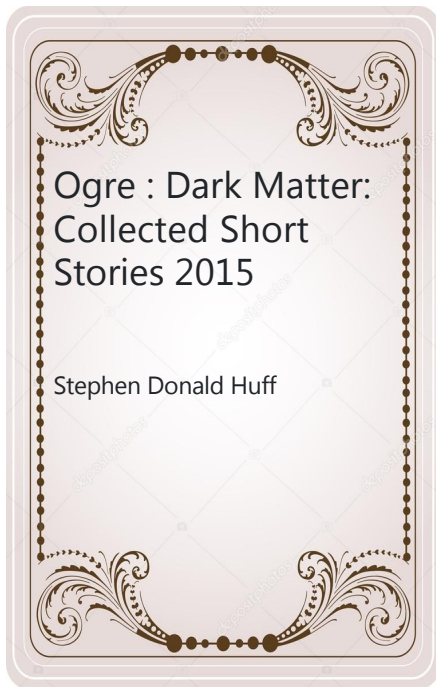


Ogre : Dark Matter: Collected Short Stories 2015
