YEARS 7 - 10 Ohayoo is a flexible, topic-based course in Japanese for the junior learner. The course is sequential, and is designed to cater for students with varying backgrounds in Japanese. It follows the successful *Konnichi wa* text by Alan Rowell and Laurel Hall. Eight modules focus on communicative contexts in which students can acquire and use the language through contacts with native speakers. A cassette has been produced to supplement the material in Ohayoo. Students are given a clear outline of the targets they should achieve by the end of each module. New language material is always followed by activities which are coded according to the skills they develop - reading, writing, speaking or listening. A Putting it all Together section at the end of each module synthesises students learning. Another feature of Ohayoo is Japan File which provides students with an insight into aspects of Japanese culture relevant to the topics being studied. The hiragana script is taught and practised throughout Ohayoo, and students are also introduced to kanji script.
