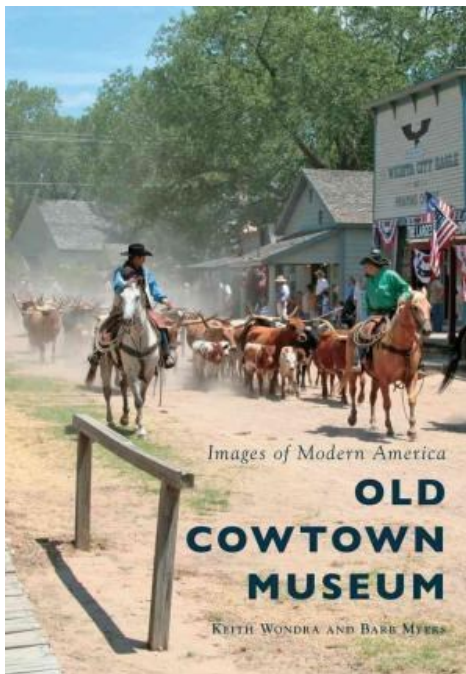


Old Cowtown Museum
